# OPEN DOOR GRANT

## Grant Overview

The Open Door Scholarship Program 2024-2025, funded by the Florida Department of Education, is designed to support students completing short-term and technical education credentialing courses. The grant covers 100% of the cost of tuition associated with the eligible courses, not otherwise covered by federal/state grants or other third-party payments.

Awarded funds only apply to the term for which the application is submitted. The student is responsible for the cost of subsequent terms. Funds are subject to availability and will be awarded once the application is approved and all other aid is applied. Refer to application for more details.

## Deadline

Submit applications in-person to the red drop box in the Office of Student Financial Aid (Main Campus - Building 11) by Friday, August 2, 2024 (12:00 PM). Allow 5-7 school days for processing. Applicants will be notified via email.

## Requirements

1. Meet eligibility for Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes.
2. Enrolled in an eligible Career Technical Education (CTE) program (refer to next page for a list).
3. Enrolled in a course starting on August 12, 2024.
4. Complete the 2024-25 FAFSA application process. Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition for the term.

## How to Apply

### New Student

1. Complete the admissions process and receive an acceptance letter from the program counselor/advisor.
2. Submit the Open Door application (page 3) to the Office of Student Financial Aid (red drop box) to determine eligibility (Main Campus - Building 11).

### Currently Enrolled Student

1. Submit the Open Door application (page 3) to the Office of Student Financial Aid (red drop box) to determine eligibility (Main Campus - Building 11).

### Returning Inactive Student

1. Contact the program counselor/advisor to discuss steps to re-enroll in the program.
2. Submit the Open Door application (page 3) to the Office of Student Financial Aid (red drop box) to determine eligibility (Main Campus - Building 11).

- The Open Door Grant applies to eligible CTE programs and is currently being offered for courses starting August 12, 2024 only.
- Students who are considered non-Florida residents for tuition purposes do not qualify even if receiving a fee exemption for out-of-state tuition fees.
- Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition for the term. Sheridan Technical College is required to reduce or cancel the grant award if the student later becomes eligible for other financial assistance during the 2024-25 school year.
- Funds are subject to availability and priority is given to currently enrolled students.
- Notification of application status will be completed no later than Friday, August 9, 2024. If awarded, funds must be used for the Fall term (August 12, 2024) only. For current students, funds will be applied to the Focus student portal. New and returning inactive students will receive an award notification letter.
- Awarded funds only apply to the term for which the application is submitted. The student is responsible for the cost of subsequent terms.
- Qualified students who have already paid out-of-pocket for the Fall (August 12, 2024) term, will be refunded eligible fees.
